It is possible to add the following activities to your tour/safari. These options may modify or extend the duration and/or program of your safari. Please don't hesitate to contact us.

Rio Elefantes Canoeing Trail (Transfrontier Park, Mozambican Side),

Three days are spent paddling the meandering river with three nights camping wild on its tree-lined banks. Our 70 km journey ends at the confluence of the elegant Elefantes and the mighty Limpopo - 'the epitome of freedom in this amazing wilderness area.'
Price: 3nights-3days (material, food and camping included) 4000 Rands
Age limit: 12years



Lebombo Hiking Trail (Transfrontier Park, Mozambican Side),

This trail takes four days and nights. It provides a true bush wilderness adventure. It traverses the spectacular slopes above the impressive Massingir dam, continues up the gorge of the Machampane River and ends in the Mopani forests of this pristine wilderness area. You will sleep over in different locations, where the adventure of the day's excursion is recalled under the African sky around a warm and welcoming campfire.
Price: 3nights-4days (Porters, material, food and camping included) 3600 Rands. 335 €
Age limit: 12years



Tsakane Wilderness Trail Camp (Balule private game reserve)

The Trail Camp has four dome safari tents, complete with comfortable camp furnishings, an outdoor shower, flush toilet and central lapa and fire. The camp specializes in providing a unique wilderness experience. Our two Trail Rangers, with some 40 years combined experience will share their knowledge with you. Activities include guided walking safaris, sleep-outs under the African stars, game drives and specialist photographic and birding excursions.

Mountain Bike Trails. (Transfrontier Park Kruger side)

Adventurers have the opportunity to combine their cycling skills with a wilderness experience in the Kruger Park. The mountain bike trails on offer, are designed to bring cyclists closer to nature than with the Kruger game drive experience. Two qualified and armed field guides will lead the trails. Backpacks, water bottles, bicycle helmets and snacks will also be provided.

Surf retreat. (Inhambane/Tofo – Mozambique)

Our destination is INHAMBANE /TOFO... MOZAMBIQUE AT ITS BEST! The Indian Ocean waters are clea and warm, averaging around 24 degrees C. The surf is seasonal, the peak being over winter (May-Augus but there is a steady flow of waves all year round. The water is marvelously warm and dolphins often frequent the break.



The main wave, Tofinho Point, is definitely not for beginners. It's a rock ledge set up that wraps around a headland. The wave breaks just off the ledge, on sand, and follows the shape off the ledge making it a very hollow wave; especially on low tide (it loves the spring tides!).

The next break is Gul's Point, another quality right hander that actually links up to Tofinho Point on a big swell, creating an amazingly long ride.

Heading about a kilometer north to the next bay brings one to the main beach of Tofo . A wide bay protected from the southerly wind and swell makes this a perfect venue for learning to surf. The swells are clean and gentle with sandbanks that gradually produce bigger waves at the Northern end of the bay - an ideal spot for beginners.

And there are other surf spots in the area that work better in different winds, ensuring that there is nearly always good surf to be had.

OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

The following activities may be booked on request during or before your Safari without modifying the proposed tour.

Rafting & Kayaking on the Sabie River.
(Mpumalanga province- 1 hour from Kruger Park entrance)

White water rafting The Sabie River provides 20 rapids (grade 2-3) with areas of scenic vegetation and outstanding birdlife viewing. This 8km route is yielding to the novice, yet accommodating to the thrill seeker within all of us. Swimming, bum sliding at "Lion's Rock". Duration: Half Day – 2.5 hours, cold beverages and snacks included.

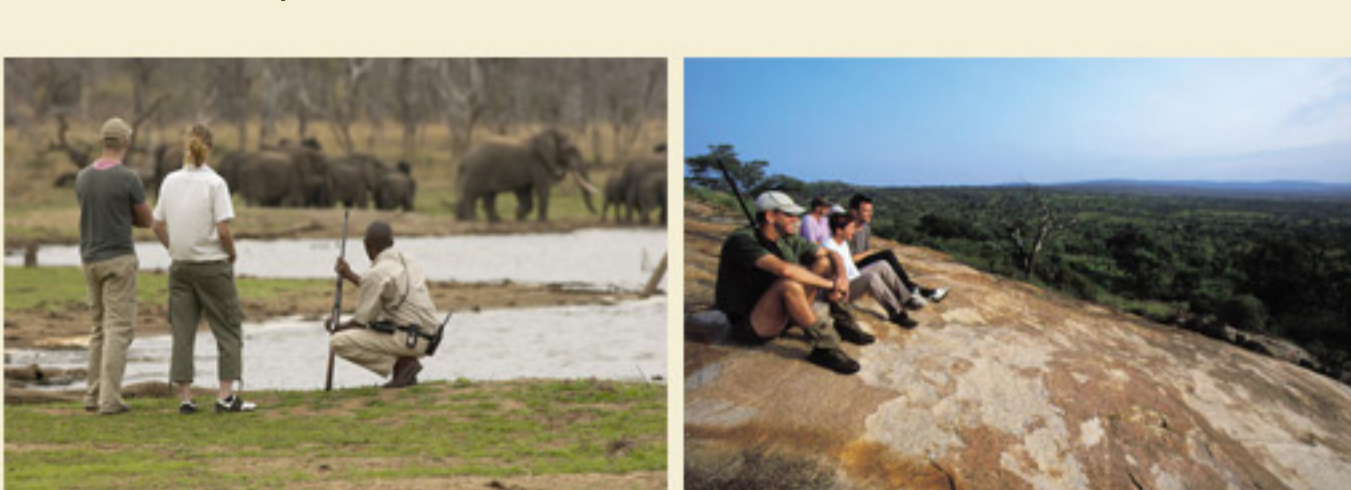
Geckoing / White Water Tubing .This is probably the best way to descend a low volume river like the Sabie. A Gecko is a very small raft that you steer with webbed gloves, no paddles needed! It is very easy to steer and very safe, and one of the coolest ways to have fun with family and friends in the sun and water! Trip duration: 2 1/2 hours

GAME WALK (KRUGER PARK):

Daily early morning and afternoon guided walks are available from most camps. Up to eight guests are taken to interesting places in the surrounding wilderness areas adjacent to most of the camps. The walk itself is relaxed, and experienced, armed guides use their knowledge of the bush to explain natural wonders.

Scuba Diving (Inhambane-Morrungulo-Vilanculos)

Scuba diving in Mozambique is amongst the best in the world, with reefs close to every beach, including the world famous Manta Reef, Gallaria, and Sylvia Shoal. Regular sightings of Giant Manta Rays, Whale Sharks, Turtles, the rare Dugong and other marine life are the norm. There are many professional scuba diving operations throughout the coast.

Charter Boat Fishing. (Inhambane-Morrungulo-Vilanculos)

Whale and dolphin Watching

Yes there are a lot of whales, dolphins and the lazy whale sharks. Whales are everywhere from July until October each year and can be seen playing with their mates and calves as they migrate past the camp each year. Often they are spotted quite close to shore. Come watch the spectacular breaching of the humpback whale as they feed and play off the reefs.
